JESUIT MISSION BAZAAR

The Indian Bazaar began in 1952 as a community event to support the works of the early Australian Jesuits who were sent to Hazaribag India; to uplift the marginalised through education and social activism. After decades of incredible service and commitment, the Jesuits now educate over 25,000 young people in India every year.

In 2020, the Indian Bazaar changed its name to the Jesuit Mission Bazaar. While Jesuit Mission's foundational roots are in India, Jesuit Mission now supports life-changing programs in over 10 countries, including India, Cambodia, Timor-Leste and Myanmar. The name change to Jesuit Mission Bazaar ensures the event title is reflective of where the much valued and vital funds from Australian community donors, supporters and partners are directed.

The Bazaar is a grassroots community event attracting over 5,000 participants with hundreds of staff, students, parents and volunteers from schools and parishes working in solidarity to create a more inclusive and just world. Since 1952 the Bazaar has been held on the grounds of Saint Ignatius' College Riverview and the event has been supported by parents, staff, alumni and students from both Saint Ignatius' College Riverview and Saint Aloysius College. The support of both Jesuit schools and the Sydney Jesuit Parishes of St Mary's and St Canice's has ensured that the tradition of the Bazaar is widely supported by the local community.

Funds raised at the Bazaar will support Jesuit programs empower women, men and children to transform their own lives and flourish. Jesuit Mission's sustainable programs around the world are diverse and include delivering life-changing teaching and education, providing essential services to refugees and displaced people, improving access to healthcare and clean water, livelihood, agriculture and food security training, emergency relief, ecology and capacity strengthening.

Father Tony Herbert, an Old Ignatian and Jesuit in Harzaribag India since 1965 recently reflected on the Bazaar:

"I picked up contact with the Bazaar again when I returned on leave from India. The most moving thing was to find my former school companions running a variety of stalls, and to get a glimpse of how much hard work they put into preparation and running it... There were unnamed volunteers in their dozens, the backbone of the whole program. It was all coins and raffle tickets and spinning wheels, but driving it all was a depth of commitment, they knew it was about something bigger and deeper."
