- All items must be clean and in good condition (no chipped glassware for example).
- Items can be left on the carpark side of the Presbytery porch under cover, near the side entrance, preferably on a Tuesday or Thursday.

Examples of what is accepted and what is not accepted:

Accepted

- Jewellery
- Corningware
- Baking items
- Fine China, Crystal items
- Teapots
- Teacups & saucers in sets
- Vases
- Bowls
- Nice candles and candle holders
- Dinner sets
- Glass sets
- Cutlery sets

NOT accepted

- Encyclopaedias
- Journals, eg National Geographics
- Magazines
- Comics
- Condensed book series, eg Readers Digest
- Electrical items
- Furniture
- Linen & towels (unless new and still in packaging or with tags)
- Ash trays
- Odd glasses, cutlery, dinner plates etc
- Toys
- Mirrors
- CDs, DVDs
